



**Over 1000 Black Sea Cross participants and many partners running for Black Sea**

**Over 1000 participants are registered for Black Sea Cross, the fourth edition. Keywords are surprises and prizes from events partners.**

The event will take place on October 27, starting at 10.00 o'clock, on Modern Beach. The Black Sea Cross keeps its noble side: the participants will run for a cleaner Black Sea, #faradeseuridinplastic (#noplactic). The race is not against time, each participant being able to do it on his own. Also, they can choose the distance to run, just as in previous years.

1. Modern Beach - House of Marriages and return - cross sector dedicated only to kindergarten students and 0-1 grades;
2. Modern Beach - University Beach (Zoom Beach) and return - short distance - 4 km;
3. Modern Beach - Reyna Beach and return - long distance - 7 km.

There is no participation fee or age limit. The partners of the event will provide prizes for all participants.

The participants will have two challenges: first one will be to wear a clothing item or an accessory that is characteristic to marine fauna and the second one will be to throw in the basket, litter found on their run route. The heating moment will be provided by 2 trainers from WorldClass Romania. There will be a relaxation and interactive corners where participants will have the opportunity to win different prizes from event's partners.

Given that the event will take place on the beach, there are a set of rules that must be followed:

- Disposal of any kind of waste on the beach or in the sea water is prohibited;
- It is forbidden the access of animals in the beach area;
- Access and vehicles parking on the beach is prohibited.
